Meeting called to order at 7:20 p.m. by President John Stransky.

Fire Rescue Department Business: Assistant Chief Reiter presented the Fire Rescue monthly report on behalf of Chief Dennis. A copy of the report is on file with the minutes. The Commission requested a copy of the “Code of Ethics Policy” once it has been reviewed by the membership and adopted by the department.

New Business: The next meeting of the Village of McFarland Police and Fire Commission will be held on Wednesday, June 15th at 9:00 a.m. in the Village Hall.

The Commission will meet for the purpose of interviewing two candidates for the open position within the police department.

A letter of appreciation will be prepared by President Stransky for Michael Brennan and signed by the Village President. The letter will recognize his many years of service to his community in the capacity as a Police and Fire Commission member.
