Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by President John Stransky.

The Commission reviewed the minutes from the June 6, 2016 meeting. Motion by Papalia second by Wagner to accept minutes as corrected. Motion carried by voice vote.

Closed Session:

Motion by Papalia seconded by Krusiec to convene in Closed Session in accordance with Wis. Stats 19.85 (1) (c) to consider employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. (Full-time police officer Interviews) Approved by a unanimous roll call vote.

Open Session:

Motion at 11:20 a.m. by Papalia second by Wagner to adjourn the Closed Session and reconvene in Open Session to act on items of business discussed in Closed Session. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

1. Motion by Papalia seconded by Wagner that PFC President Stransky prepare a letter to Police Chief Sherven detailing candidates in rank order in accordance with the League of Wisconsin Municipalities Handbook for Wisconsin Police and Fire Commissioners page 34, "A Commission adopts rules governing how candidates, determined to be eligible for appointment are listed". Motion carried.
2. The Commission has received a letter from Police Chief Sherven stating that Anthony Craft has successfully completed the field training process. He recommends the appointment of Officer Craft. Letter on file with minutes. Motion by Papalia seconded Krusiec to officially appoint Anthony Craft to the position of Police Officer. Motion carried. Officer Craft will continue to serve the remainder of his 18 month probationary period.
