

## **PROOF OF RESIDENCE**

***PROOF OF RESIDENCE IS NEEDED FOR REGISTRATION, WHILE PHOTO ID IS NEEDED FOR VOTING. THEY ARE NOT THE SAME THING, BUT SOME FORMS ARE ACCEPTABLE FOR BOTH.***

The following constitute acceptable Proof-of-Residence for Voter Registration if the document contains the voter's full name and address: (Per <http://gab.wi.gov/elections-voting/voters/registration-voting> )

1. A current and valid Wisconsin driver's license.
2. A current and valid Wisconsin identification card.
3. Any other official identification card or license issued by a Wisconsin governmental body or unit.
4. Any identification card issued by an employer in the normal course of business and bearing a photo of the card holder, but not including a business card.
5. A real estate tax bill or receipt for the current year or the year preceding the date of the election.
6. A residential lease which is effective for a period that includes election day (**NOT for first-time voters registering by mail**).
7. A university, college or technical institute fee card (must include photo).
8. A university or college ID with a photo and a fee payment receipt that contains the student's residential address dated no earlier than nine months before the election.
9. A university or college student ID with a photo if the university or college has provided a certified list to the municipal clerk of students, containing the students' residential addresses and indicating which students are U.S. citizens.
10. A gas, electric or telephone service statement (utility bill) for the period commencing not earlier than 90 days before election day.
11. Bank statement.
12. Paycheck.
13. A check or other document issued by a unit of government.
