

Pet License and Dog Park Permit Application

Dog and Cat Licenses (Pet Licenses)

Pet licenses are issued on a calendar year basis. A license is required for dogs and cats over 5 months of age. ***Proof of rabies vaccination from your veterinarian stating the manufacturer name, serial number of the vaccine, the date the rabies vaccination was given, and expiration date of the vaccination must be provided before a license can be issued.*** Please remember to include this information. Due to the high volume of counter traffic during December and January tax collections, we will not be able to call your veterinarian to obtain this information. Dog and cat license fees are listed below. This application can also be found online at www.mcfarland.wi.us under the Administration Department, Licenses and Permits.

For renewal licenses issued after **March 31, 2016**, a **\$5.00 late fee** will be assessed. If your dog is new to McFarland after March 31, 2016, there is no late fee.

McFarland Dog Exercise Area Permits (Dog Park Permits)

The McFarland Dog Exercise Area is located in Urso Park, at 6201 Elvehjem Road. The Dog Park has seven acres (fully fenced) with amenities including a parking lot, benches, pet waste bags, and disposal stations. Hours of operation are 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Both a current dog park permit and dog license are required, and your pet must be wearing the respective dog license and dog park permit tags. The annual Dog Park Permit is good from January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016. Dog Park Permits fees are listed below.

Payment options for both Pet Licenses and Dog Park Permits

1. **In person** at the Administration Department, 5915 Milwaukee Street, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
2. **By mail** with a check made payable to the "Village of McFarland", a completed application, and a self-addressed stamped envelope (must be included in order for your license, permit, and tag to be returned by mail) to: Village of McFarland Administration Department, P.O. Box 110, McFarland, WI, 53558-0110.
3. **Drop off** in the drop box located in the vestibule of the front entrance of the McFarland Municipal Center, 5915 Milwaukee Street with a check made payable to the "Village of McFarland", a completed application, and a self-addressed stamped envelope (must be included in order for your license, permit, and tag to be returned by mail). The drop box is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
