Dog and Cat Licenses (Pet Licenses)

- Pet Licenses are good from January 1 to December 31 each year.
- Licenses are required for all dogs and cats over 5 months of age.
- A Certificate of Rabies Vaccination from your veterinarian stating the manufacturer name, serial number of the vaccine, the date the rabies vaccination was given, and expiration date of the vaccination must be provided before a license can be issued. If applying in person in the Administration Department, an electronic copy will be accepted.
- For renewal licenses issued after March 31 of each year, a \$5.00 late fee will be assessed.

McFarland Dog Park Permits

- The McFarland Dog Park is located in Urso Park and accessible from Elvehjem Road.
- The Dog Park has seven acres (fully fenced) with amenities including a parking lot, restrooms, indoor and outdoor (seasonal) washing stations, pet waste bags, and disposal stations.
- Hours of operation are 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Both a current Dog Park Permit and Dog License are required. For non-residents, the Dog Licenses must be from the municipality in which the dog lives.
- Dogs must display Dog License tags and Dog Park Permit tags at all times in the Dog Park.
- Dog Park Permits are good from January 1 to December 31 each year.
- Non-Residents applying for a Dog Park Permit must provide proof that each dog has a current Dog License from the municipality in which the dog lives – A picture of the tag or copy of the license is sufficient.
