MARCH 2019 MONTHLY REPORT

As observed on the attached Call Summary Report, the McFarland Police Department logged 849 cases in March. This is compared to 604 cases for the same time period in 2018. Cases of interest for the month were: six intoxicated drivers, one domestic disturbances, six disturbances, eight juvenile complaints, six thefts, seven traffic accidents, forty-one EMS/Fire assists, and responded to eight alarms. Officers also logged 328 traffic incidents during this month.

Cases of interest for the month are as follows:

03/13/2019 An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding and found the driver was under the influence of alcohol. The driver was asked to perform field sobriety tests. The officer was able to establish probable cause to arrest him for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence. The driver had a .24 blood alcohol concentration. It should be noted the same driver was arrested in February for OMVWI and had a blood alcohol concentration of .25 at that time.

Staffing Report

- A final candidate has been selected for the Police Clerk III recruitment. The pre-employment background investigation is underway. Once successfully passed, an offer of employment will be made with hopes to have the employee on board by the end of April.
- Retired Police Clerk Bonnie Evans continues to fill our front office vacancy on an LTE basis.
- We continue at one officer short due to a shoulder injury received during an altercation with a suspect in the course of an arrest.

Training Report

- Sgt. Maurer, SRO Miller, and Officer Onken attended a Threat Assessment training in Oshkosh, WI.
- Officer Bryant attended Gracie Survival Tactics in Green Bay, WI.
- Officer Bryant attended RADAR Certification training at Madison College.

Budget Report

- Our injured officer situation has put us slightly ahead of where we should be in terms of overtime expenditures. We will continue to monitor this as the year progresses.

Other Information

- I am scheduling a meeting of the Dane County Chief's Association CAPMAR Committee to plan a CAPMAR drill in the coming months. We will be meeting later this month to discuss logistics, and likely will conduct the drill in the City of Stoughton. Our desire for this drill is to conduct it in a jurisdiction that has a separate dispatch center from the County 911 Center. This will allow us to assess radio interoperability in that type of scenario.
