Dog and Cat Licenses (Pet Licenses)

- Pet Licenses are good from January 1 to December 31 each year.
- Licenses are required for all dogs and cats over 5 months of age.
- A Certificate of Rabies Vaccination from your veterinarian stating the manufacturer name, serial number of the vaccine, the date the rabies vaccination was given, and expiration date of the vaccination must be provided before a License can be issued.
- For renewal Licenses issued after March 31 of each year, a \$5.00 late fee will be assessed.

McFarland Dog Exercise Area Permits (Dog Park Permits)

- The McFarland Dog Exercise Area is located in Urso Park at 6201 Elvehjem Road.
- The Dog Park has seven acres (fully fenced) with amenities including a parking lot, benches, pet waste bags, and disposal stations.
- Hours of operation are 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Both a current Dog Park Permit and Dog License are required.
- Dogs must display Dog License tags and Dog Park Permit tags at all times in the Exercise Area.
- Dog Park Permits are good from January 1 to December 31 each year.
