To: Residents Affected by the 2020 Water Main Improvements and Street Resurfacing
Subject: Project Details

Dear Residents:

Many of you are already aware that the Village will be constructing water main and street improvements on the following streets this year:

- Autumn Lane (Main Street to Timber Lane)
 - Includes water main and street improvements
- Burma Road (USH 51 to 1400' east of USH 51)
 - Includes water main and street improvements

In coordination with the work above, the Village will also be replacing damaged curb and gutter and pulverizing and repaving the following streets this year:

- North Autumn Lane (Timber Lane to Siggelkow Road)
- Creamery Court (Creamery Road to end)

The project will start on or about June 8 with work beginning on Autumn Lane and Burma Road. It is anticipated that curb and gutter replacements may begin near the beginning of July and that pulverizing and repaving on all of the streets will take place in late July or early August. The overall schedule will depend on several things, including weather. All work is scheduled for completion by September 15.

As construction gets underway, there are several items that are important to know during the project. G-Pro Excavating will be the general contractor for the project. On the first group of streets listed above, the water main work will be first. During the installation of the new water main, there will be periods of time (2-4 hours) when some residents will be without water service. The contractor is required to notify all affected residents 24 hours prior to any scheduled service interruptions. Water shut-downs will be required to tie the new main into the existing water main, and also during the switch-over from a home's old lateral to its new lateral.

To facilitate the installation of new water main on **Autumn Lane**, it will be necessary for the Contractor to provide residents on Autumn Lane with a temporary water service line. The installation of the temporary service line is expected to begin as early as **June 2**. If you have any questions about this temporary service line, please contact Town & Country Engineering Inc. The contractor will maintain access to all homes as much as possible during construction. However, there will be periods of time that trenching will cross driveways or intersections and will require temporary closures. Residents will be notified prior to any driveway closure so they may move their vehicles, if needed. All driveways will have access restored at the end of each work day.

However, during the construction of the new curb & gutter and new concrete driveways, no traffic will be allowed on the new concrete for seven days, to allow the concrete to harden properly. If a homeowner wishes to change their driveway material or expand their driveway width, please contact Town & County Engineering, Inc. (608-273-3350)

Emergency vehicles will have access throughout the project. While garbage pick-up should remain unaffected, mailboxes may have to be temporarily relocated to intersections as designated by the Postmaster and will be replaced once the project is complete.

Please note that there may be excavation and disturbance approximately 5 feet beyond the existing edge of roadway, and further in areas where water laterals must be replaced. Residents with invisible fencing, irrigation systems, or landscaping in these areas are strongly encouraged to relocate them in advance of the crews. Attempts will be made to salvage items left in the Village right-of-way, but they will likely become damaged.
